MINNESOTA HOUSE VOTE: INCREASED FUNDING FOR NURSING HOMES

On March 30, 2023, Minnesota Rep. Paul Torkelson (R-Hanska) moved that the House vote on bill HF733, which would bring reimbursement payments to nursing homes up to date to account for inflation. The additional payments would have given nursing homes more adequate funding that would more adequately cover increased cost of nurses and other workers, meals, facility costs, etc., which were forcing some nursing homes to close, leaving some residents without care. A majority of legislators voted down the motion to consider the payments increase bill, 58-70, leaving state reimbursement and support rates at such low levels that nursing homes would have to cut services, or in some cases, to close.
